Rope Rescue Training 2018 Mountain Rope Safety Courses

All classes held at the Signal Mountain site **include Lodging**. Personnel will have bunk bed with sheets, pillows, towels for shower, full kitchen, living room area, WFI, and a TV. Handouts or manuals provided as well as all gear used during the rope rescue class. There is a laundromat at the foot of Signal Mountain for those wishing to wash cloths.

Personnel Must Bring: Tight fitting pair of gloves (Leather or Deer type), Helmet Light, Extra Batteries, food and water for field class times in backcountry. Eye Protection and Knee Pads and Boots to protect personnel ankles. Also if attending Operational Rope Rescue personnel will need an ATV or Mountain Bike of some kind, in order to get to one of the sites or be willing to walk 3 miles into the backcountry & 3 miles out. Please bring a rain suite and weather appropriate clothing! Please bring your personal toiletries. If you have an appropriate helmet and harness you may bring that and it will be checked by an instructor before allowed for class evolutions. Must have vehicle, in order to drive to different site trail heads (ride sharing strongly suggested). Bug Repellant & Poison Ivy Soap, should personnel need it in the back country. It is strongly suggested that personnel attending rope rescue classes purchase and bring Vitalyte for an electrolyte replacement drink (Can be purchased off Amazon or R.E.I.).

Provided for Personnel: Certificate of completion from Progressive Rescue Solutions, Inc. & Tennessee Association of Rescue Squads, with 1.0 CEU upon passing the course. They will be mailed to personnel within 6 weeks. All classes meet or exceed NFPA standards 1006 & 1670 for Awareness, Operations or Technician. This is dependent on which class you attend. Each student will be provided a manual or handout, Prusik Cord and pen to keep. Personnel will be given a written exam at the end of the course. A letter of confirmation will be emailed to personnel when registration and payment is received for classes.

All students must be prepared for strenuous work and lots of knowledge applied in a short time! Evenings are for rest and study. Usually students get together and go out for dinner one or two nights. There is a grill on site. There are a few fast food restaurants on the mountain as well as enjoyable full service restaurants. Some like to go to Chattanooga, which is only 10 miles away, off the mountain.

Prerequisites: None for Low Angle Rope Rescue, Rescue Rappelling or Operational Rope Rescue.

Begin **8AM-6PM** each day, not including travel times to backcountry sites.

The Other Classes may vary in time but normally 32-40 hours which will be denoted on schedule.
